SYNOPSIS

In a remote Bihar village, an outcast family struggles with poverty and discrimination. The father worked as a daily labourer, earning just enough to keep hunger away. One day, seeing no other way, he left the village to find work in the city, leaving behind his young wife and their newborn son. The mother, alone in the broken house, battling the heavy sadness of new motherhood, was unable to feed their baby. The baby's cries became harder to bear, and loneliness wrapped around her like a snake.

Their lives became tied to a crematorium worker, tormented by guilt after burning an unnamed body for a few coins. Unable to live with his mistake, he longed to wash away his sins and find forgiveness. In the end, when all three cross paths, their broken lives crash into one another and what follows is a storm of pain, anger, and regret that spares no one.



Set against the backdrop of Bihar, "Swaha" captures the region's rich cultural heritage and contemporary challenges. The film delves into broader themes of poverty, caste discrimination, and the quest for dignity. My personal association with Buddhist ideas significantly shaped the narrative, allowing for a deeper exploration of suffering, compassion, and the path to enlightenment.

I chose a stark black-and-white visual style to reflect the harsh realities faced by the characters. The narrative structure weaves together moments of hope and despair, mirroring the protagonist's tumultuous journey.

Through sound design, I aimed to create a psychological space where pain often masquerades as fear, adding depth to the emotional landscape.

Creating "Swaha" has been a transformative journey, deepening my understanding of resilience and hope. This film stands as a testament to the human spirit's capacity to endure and transcend, marking a significant milestone in my career as a filmmaker.

DIRECTOR'S STATEMENT

Abhilash Sharma is an independent filmmaker from India, known for creating emotionally powerful and socially rooted stories. With a background in theatre and a passion for visual storytelling, Abhilash has directed a range of short films, documentaries, and feature projects that explore human emotions, culture, and social issues. His film *Swaha* won the prestigious Golden Goblet Award at the Shanghai International Film Festival, earning critical acclaim. Committed to authentic storytelling, Abhilash believes in using cinema as a medium to spark conversations and connect deeply with audiences.
